Mansfield Public Schools Automated Attendance Calling



The Mansfield Public Schools generate automated calls and emails with our School Messenger Notification system to notify parents when their student is marked absent from school. Calls will be made to parents of students in grades 1 – 12 and will be generated during the day according to the following schedule:

School	Time
Robinson Elementary	10:15 AM
Jordan Jackson Elementary	10:00 AM
Qualters Middle School	9:45 AM
Mansfield High School	6:00 PM

Q: If I call the school in the morning to notify them of my child's absence, will I still receive a call and email?

A: No, as long as you notify the school before 9:30 a.m.

Q: What phone number will the attendance calls be made to?

A: By default, phone calls will be made to the student's home phone number. If you would like to add an additional phone number for attendance calls, please contact the main office at your child's school.

Q: What email address will be used for attendance emails?

A: Attendance emails will be sent to the email address of the individual listed as the primary contact for the student.

Q: What should I do if I want to receive attendance emails at a secondary address?

A: At this time, our School Messenger Notification system allows for one email address per student.

Q: Who should I contact if I have questions about this new attendance calling feature?

A: Please contact the main office at the school your child attends for answers to your questions.
